

This instruction sheet is to support the field installation of Service Entrance Barrier Kits in Siemens Revised P1 Panelboards. Kit SEBKRP1V1 is for an FD, QJ or QR Main Breaker; kit SEBKRP1V2 is for an ED Main Breaker. This covers both single and three phase panels, either top or bottom fed.

- 1. Lock off ALL power supplying this equipment before working on it.
- 2. Remove the panelboard front cover and deadfront.
- 3. Identify the deadfront support closest to the service terminals of the service disconnect: On top-fed units, the service terminals are in the upper left corner; on bottom-fed units, the service terminals are in the lower right corner.
- 4. Remove the single deadfront support mounting screw and withdraw that deadfront support from the panel interior.
- 5. Position the Barrier Support Assembly (Item 1) onto the deadfront support such that the half-shear penetrates the hole nearest the 90 degree bend.
- 6. Secure the Barrier Support Assembly to the deadfront support using the hole nearest the 45 degree bend, as shown. Tighten the screw (Item 2) to 30 lb-in.
- 7. Reinstall the deadfront support using the mounting screw removed in Step 4. Tighten the screw to 30 lb-in.
- 8. **Before energizing the panel**, ensure that ALL connections have been properly torqued, that the barrier is in place and secure, that the deadfront is installed and that all fillers are in place.
